

CLIENT BILL OF RIGHTS

CONSUMERS OF PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES OFFERED BY PSYCHOLOGISTS LICENSED BY THE STATE OF MINNESOTA HAVE THE RIGHT:

- A. To expect that a psychologist has met the minimal qualifications of training and experience required by state law;
- B. To examine public records maintained by the Board of Psychology which contains the credentials of a psychologist;
- C. To obtain a copy of the rules of conduct from the State Register and Public Documents Division, Department of Administration, 117 University Avenue, St. Paul, MN 55155;
- D. To report complaints to the Board of Psychology; 2700 University Avenue, West; Suite 101; St Paul., MN 55114;
- E. To be informed of the cost of professional services before receiving the services;
- F. To privacy as defined by rule and law;
- G. To be free from being the object of discrimination on the basis of race, religion, gender, or other unlawful category while receiving psychological services;
- H. To have access to their records as provided in subpart 1a and Minnesota Statutes, Section 144.335, subdivision 2; and
- I. To be free from exploitation for the benefit or advantage of the psychologist.
